



HOW TO APPLY? ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

D. Pharm First Year

- The Candidate should be an Indian National
- Passed 10+2 examination with Physics and Chemistry as compulsory subjects along with Mathematics / Biology subject. Other than Maharashtra state candidates shall be eligible for institution quota only.

B. Pharm First Year

(A) Maharashtra State Candidature

- The candidate should be an Indian National
- Passed HSC in Science stream with Physics & Chemistry as compulsory subject along with one of the Mathematics or Biology subject & obtained at least 45 % marks (at least 40 % marks in case of candidates of backward class categories & person with disability belonging only to Maharashtra State) in the above subjects taken together.
- Should have appeared in all the subjects & should obtain non zero score in CET conducted by the Competent Authority

(B) All India Candidature

Should obtain non zero positive score in NEET or CET.

B. Pharm Second Year (Lateral Entry)

- The candidate should be an Indian National
- Passed Diploma course in Pharmacy with at least 45% marks (at least 40 % marks in case of candidates of Backward class categories & person with disability belonging to Maharashtra state only) from an AICTE or PCI or Central or State Government approved institution or its equivalent.
