

#### Feedback analysis and reward/ corrective measures:



Each head is measured in the category of four different grades. The overall score is calculated on the scale of 0 to 100. Soon after the feedback collection the coordinator circulates the overall ratings of all faculties for necessarily action. The list of faculties having overall score below 80% is made available for corrective measures.

#### **Corrective Measures:**

Discussion of all Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) members is carried out after first feedback with those faculties who score below 80%. The points of discussion about the preparation of the subject, student class control, student counselling, etc. and advised them to improve by the next feedback giving concentration on the item where they are lagging. Follow-up of their feedback is carried out after 15 days or before 2<sup>nd</sup> sessional examination, if no any improvement found in II<sup>nd</sup> feedback, disciplinary action will be recommended to the higher authority.

#### **System of Reward:**

As detailed in graphical representation of faulty feedback process, ADCBP has designed a process of feedback in which the faculties are issued a letter of appreciation for achieving average excellence (Above 95% score) in the teaching feedback. The letter of appreciation is issued by the head of institute to the faculty.
