Discussion: Members were invited to raise any additional matters for discussion or consideration. The Chairperson encouraged open communication related to any other matters, however, no point was raised by committee members.


The meeting concluded with a summary of key decisions, action to be taken, and the date and time for the next IQAC meeting.
