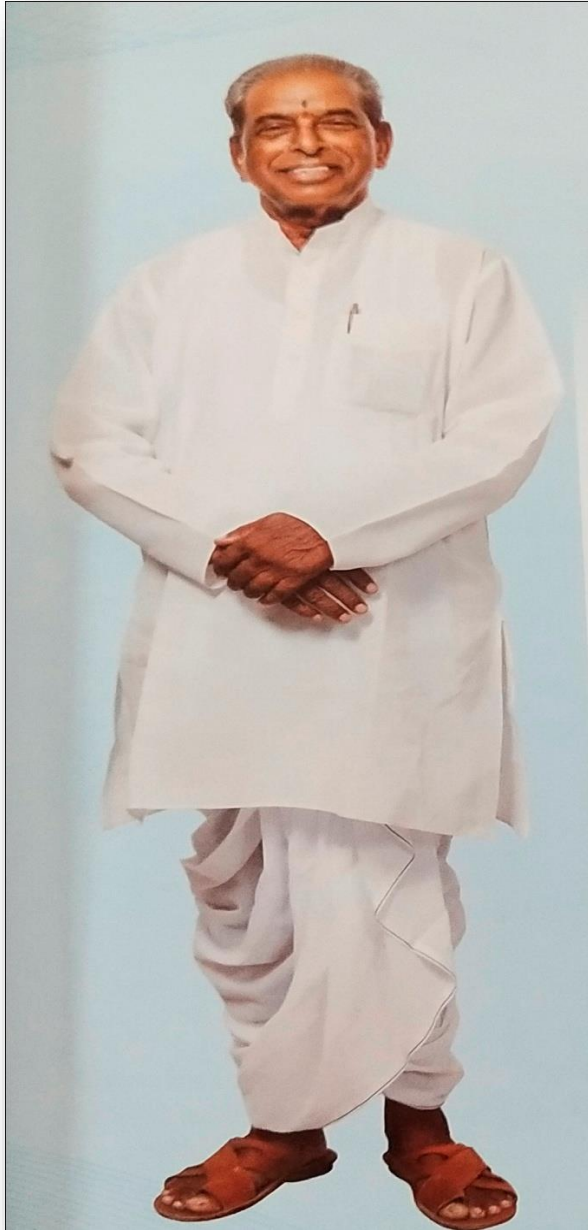

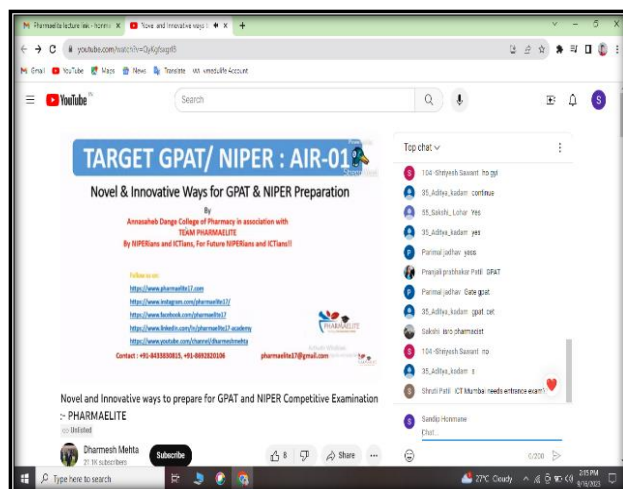

## Teachers Day Celebration

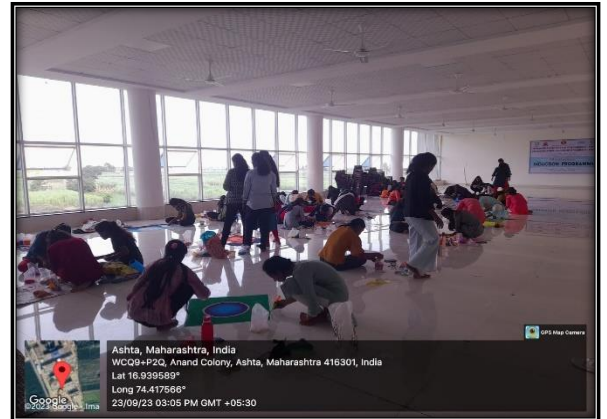

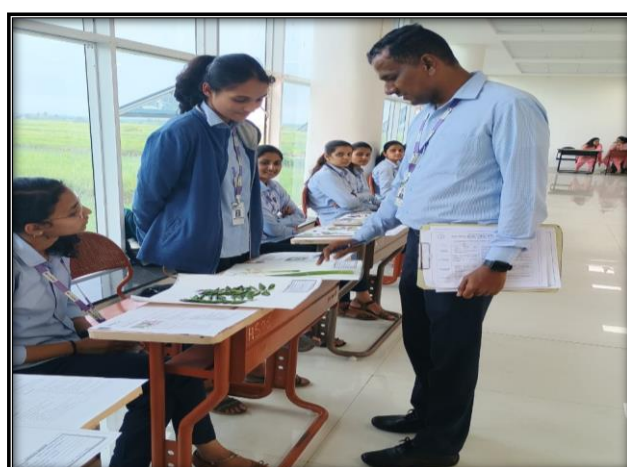


## National Pharmacy Week Celebration

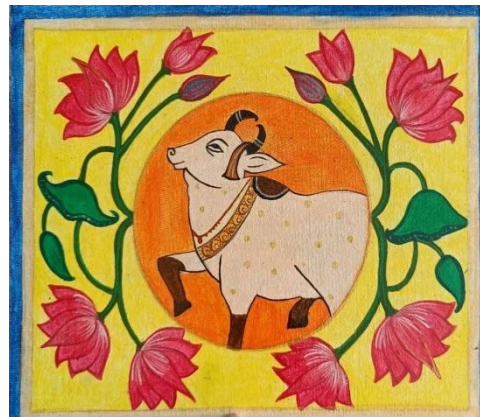

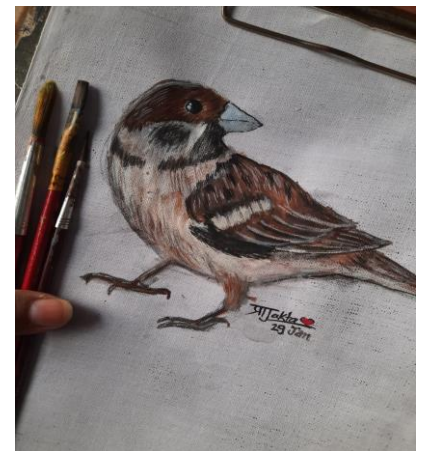
